Day 2 – Mosi-oa-Tunya NP and Victoria Falls

It's a fantastic opportunity to experience nature at ground level, check out some tracks, and chat about plants and their uses. Our mission? Get up close to some White Rhinos. After this active adventure, we'll chill out with a picnic by the river.

And of course, a visit to Livingstone wouldn't be complete without witnessing the majestic Victoria Falls, and that's exactly on the agenda for the afternoon.

Day 3-4 - Southern Kafue NP

Day 4 brings us to feeding time for the little elephants, and we're excited to pay them a visit. Accommodations? Cozying up in our spacious canvas dome tents.

Day 5-6 – Central Kafue NP

Heading a bit more north within Kafue National Park now. This park is like Zambia's wildlife hotspot, the biggest and most diverse. Imagine it's as vast as Wales or Massachusetts. Since we're right within this wildlife haven, we roll on a game drive all the way to the next camp. Picture us crossing tiny creeks, cruising over hills, eyes peeled for any critters and feathered friends. Our camp nestles along the Kafue River, and we'll be chilling in our comfy large canvas dome tents. Day 6? More game drive loops on the agenda!
